(for High School /ROP Students)

- 1. Apply and be admitted to Santiago Canyon College (SCC)

- 3. Obtain an official and sealed copy of your high school transcript and schedule an appointment with Lisa Westerhout, the CTE Transitions counselor, by calling (714) 628-4800.
- 4. The CTE Transitions counselor will review your transcript and discuss the process for receiving college credit for your ROP course.
