Welcome the ROP Career & Technical Institute. We are proud of this facility, its equipment, and the career technical education instruction and support provided by our staff. We hope you not only enjoy your time here with us, but also help us maintain an attractive campus conducive to learning. Please read the following information about campus life and student expectations at our facility, and then join our efforts by signing the agreement below.

**STUDENT ELIGIBILITY:**

Students must be available for the entire course schedule. ROP cannot make accommodations for personal schedules.

Students must have successfully completed at least the Medical Careers course in order to qualify for a Capstone class in the Patient Care Career Pathway. Priority registration is given to students who have completed the Body Systems and Disorders course.

Students must have transportation to attend and exit class on time. ROP and its partner districts cannot provide transportation. ROP regional courses are held at various locations throughout our five partner districts and at the Trident Education Center, 1800 W. Ball Road, Anaheim.

**BREAKS:** Instructors may dismiss students for a short unsupervised break, especially if administration has designated a specific time for lunch or dinner. Students need to bring their own snacks or meal as there is not sufficient time to leave campus. Students are accountable for returning to class on time. **ROP assumes no responsibility or liability for students once they leave the building.**

**ALCOHOL, DRUG & TOBACCO FREE CAMPUS:** Under no circumstances is drinking alcohol, smoking tobacco (including electronic cigarettes/vaporizers) or using recreational or non-prescription drugs allowed on campus including the building, parking lots, and grassy areas. (BP 5131.6)

**FOOD & DRINK:** In order to prevent vermin, food and drink should not be consumed in the classrooms unless given permission by the administration. Bottled water is the exception. Students may bring and consume food and drink in the designated student break areas.
